PRESCRIPTION MEDICINE BOTTLES!

Lydia Guild has taken on a new project along with Matthew 25 Ministries to recycle <u>PRESCRIPTION</u> pill bottles. (No over the counter bottles, please). It provides a way to distribute meds to the poor in other countries, in <u>CAPPED</u>, unlabeled containers. It also helps keep thousands of bottles out of landfills each year. Remove the label, thoroughly clean and rinse.

LWML-CID GRANTS

Each month, one of the LWML-CID mission grants will be featured in our newsletter.

\$10,000 Grant - Fort Wayne and St. Louis Seminary Food Banks

This grant will assist both seminary food banks in stocking their shelves for students and their families.

\$3,350 Grant - Human Trafficking Education Human trafficking is a modern term for slavery and is the fastest growing and most lucrative criminal activity in the world.
