## ***Larry Brandt Memorial Scholarship***

### **Scholarship Details**

St. John's Lutheran Church has established a Scholarship Fund to support the youth in our congregation as they pursue a post-secondary education. The primary purpose of this fund is to support those youth attending an LCMS or Lutheran Institution and pursuing a career in Church Work. Additionally, if funding is available, scholarships will be awarded to youth attending other Christian or Non-religious Institutions.

### **Award Details**

- Only applicants who have been members in good standing at St. John's Lutheran Church for a minimum of one year and who attend worship services on a regular basis are eligible.
- Students must be enrolled in or attending an accredited College or University pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree. After the first year in school, applicants for funding for subsequent years must remain in good standing and be making progress towards a degree according to the standards of the institution.
- Scholarships will be made payable to the institution and must be applied to tuition and/or books.

### **Criteria and Weighting**

All qualified applicants will be eligible for a portion of the scholarship pool, with the actual amount based on the weighting factors identified here. Among the factors that will be considered:

1. School affiliation
  - a. LCMS
  - b. Other Lutheran
  - c. Other Christian
  - d. Non-religious Private or Public Institution
2. College Major
  - a. Church Work Career
  - b. Secular Career
3. Church activity level

### **Application Details**

- All interested students must complete and submit an application indicating their desire to apply.
- As part of the application you will be asked to include a brief narrative of your personal involvement in Christian activities over the past year, you are also asked to complete a short-essay answering "How can Christ use me to serve Him and others in college and in my chosen career field?"
- Applications are available in the church office, on the main hall bulletin board or online at [stjohnslcms.net](http://stjohnslcms.net)
- Applications must be submitted to the Church Office by April 10<sup>th</sup> to be considered.
- Awards will be determined and recipients notified.
