On behalf of the Papua New Guinea Mission Society (PNGMS), Garry and Charla Wolff and Todd and Janet Luedtke would like to thank the generous fellow Christians of the Altamont-Effingham area who donated books to the children of the Gutnius Lutheran Church of Papua New Guinea.

Books were donated by members of St. Peter; Immanuel; Faith, Shumway, Bethlehem and St. John's, Effingham. The collected donations amounted to more than 5,000 pounds of books, which were taken with another 12,000 pounds of books collected in the St. Louis area to Orphan Grain Train in Norfolk, Nebraska where they were sorted, packed and loaded for shipment to the children. The total shipment came to over 36,000 books, weighing over fifteen tons!
