TOPIC FOR SUNDAY SCHOOL STUDENTS: Lesson 12

"A Prophet Serves" is the title for this week's lesson. Having been raised in the tabernacle from the time he was a young child, Samuel continues to serve Eli the priest. I don't remember the first time God offended me -- that is, the first time that the truth of His Law made me feel the shame and guilt that I deserve. I might have been four, or maybe fourteen. No doubt: God was right. And so was His representative (most likely, my mom or dad). The Law shows us our sin. The Gospel shows us our Savior, Jesus.

It certainly wasn't the first time, but I vividly remember a time when the Gospel set me free. I had ruined something my dad had made. I fessed up, probably slowly. Then I was forgiven – by my dad and by my Father. I think it seemed too good to be true. But it wasn't. Undeserved? You bet. True? You better believe it.

Here at St. John's I get to stand in a pulpit occupied by tremendous pastors before me, preaching and teaching Law and Gospel. If it hasn't already happened, you're going to be deeply offended some day by my preaching and teaching. I hope it will only be because the truth of His Word has touched your mind and heart, exposing how you have ruined something or someone He has made. Don't go away when that happens. Lean in.

Lean in and listen as the Gospel goes even deeper. The mercy of God in Jesus covers all your sin. Repent and believe. It's not too good to be true. You are forgiven for Jesus' sake. Truly? You better believe it! Rejoice, too, that God restores those things and people we think have been ruined. Keep listening,
