TOPIC FOR SUNDAY SCHOOL TODAY Children & Adults

"Homecoming Hopes" is the theme for our lesson this week. Artaxerxes sends Ezra as a priest and scribe to teach and lead the people at the newly repaired temple in Jerusalem. Nehemiah convinces the king to send him to Jerusalem to repair the city wall. Despite opposition from Israel's neighbors, repairs are completed in record time. Nehemiah, Ezra, and the priests lead the people in a joyous rededication of the wall. **Discuss** together, "What homecoming can we look forward to as God's children?"

Response-able. That's the awkward and helpful word that Dr. Ken Schurb in our District office uses when he discusses Christian stewardship. God gives gifts. We get to respond. And we're able to do it. "Response-able" is a nice way to put it.

Today I urge you to think about next year, which is only three weeks away. Think about the gifts God is placing in your lives - gifts of forgiveness and certain hope. Gifts of people and places. Gifts of skills. time. and and finances. Acknowledge that they are all gifts. Respond in faith and joy. You are able, because He is generous and present. St. Paul wrote, "Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly under compulsion, or for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work. As it is written, "He has distributed freely. He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever." (2 Cor. 9:7-9)

I witnessed some mighty responses last Sunday afternoon as I sat in on the youth Christmas Service rehearsal! We have wonderful children and families, and the message they are preparing for next Saturday night is focused on Jesus. What a joyful response!

Pray this week about what your response will include in 2020. Will you volunteer in a new way in our congregation through our prayer ministry or food bank? As a Sunday School teacher or Welcome Center greeter? I'm so new here I don't know all the opportunities there are for you. Volunteer, and we'll find out together.
