FROM OUR PASTOR....



Like the Burdicks, you might find yourself in a new place geographically

this Lent. But probably not. Most likely, your place is largely the same, with some adjustments. But places aren't only physical. They are also relational and spiritual. We'll be touring all three dimensions together soon.

This Lent we'll be walking through the Passion of Jesus according to Luke's Gospel. What is important in these places is not the physical surroundings but the spiritual dispositions of the people who gather there. Again and again, we will see God's people, from the religious and political leaders to the disciples, revealing the sinful ways of the human heart. Yet, again and again, Jesus will reveal how he enters these physical places to bring about salvation and spiritual change. The most troubling places of our lives become the most amazing places of God's grace when Jesus visits them. Beginning February 26, Ash Wednesday, plan to be part of our Lenten journey in three ways:

- 1. Every Sunday (or Saturday) worship.
- 2. Wednesday midweek Services (12:15 & 6:30pm).
- Special home devotions through Lutheran Hour Ministries titled, "DELIVER US: Jesus Sets Us Free." We will make these available next weekend.
