Again? By Rev. John Gierke

"Potatoes again??" That's what a family friend in our church years ago told us about a memory of his from when he was growing up as a boy. They had potato after potato (mashed, baked, fried, etc.) day after day for quite some time, and he was tired of them!

All the various times I have been around the children eating their meals at the schools in Haiti, not once did I hear "Beans and rice again??" or "YUK!" Instead, I heard thanksgiving and joy in their mealtime prayers and songs, thanking Jesus for the food, followed by the scraping of every bean and grain of rice out of the bowl!

I suppose, given our sinful human nature, there may have been a child or two who grumbled a little, but if so, I never heard it or noticed an unhappy face at lunchtime! For many of the children, that bowl of beans and rice is their only meal all day, and they are grateful! For others, it adds to the little bit that their family does have that they share with one another.

A quarter may get us only a gum ball from a vending machine here in the United States, but it provides a fulfilling, appreciated meal for a child at our school in Haiti, together with the HOPE of Jesus Christ and His name on their lips and lives!
