PRECIOUS GIFT

One of my fondest mission trip memories was while visiting schools in the Jeremie district. The children were so excited to have guests from the United States. The classroom was a partial building that overlooked the ocean. They sat shoulder to shoulder with separate classes facing different directions. Many had their only composition book out, taking notes while others were making drawings in anticipation of their visitors. As the mission team members were visiting the children, many of the kids were eager to show the team special drawings they had worked so hard on. It was very touching to be given this heart felt work from these children who were so full of joy and with smiles ear to ear. They had so little and that paper they used for our drawings was the same one they had used to write their homework and lessons on from the blackboard, but yet used them to make a special gift for us.

Just as precious is receiving school correspondence packets three times a year from Haiti with all the letters, drawings and pictures each school has put together for their school sponsor. In those letters they share a part of themselves. Let me share with you one of the recent letters. This was written in English, which is not their first language, and reads:

"Hello. My name is Mirline. I'm 10 old, I love you for the food, that we give us. Because some time my parents cannot give me to eat so she does not have money for that. It's only Sundays that we eat normally. While God Bless you in everything. Love you."
