The man's ears open and his tongue releases, but Jesus warns the crowd not to tell anyone. "The good news cannot be contained, however, and those who witness the miracle share the story. Discuss, "How can we share the Good News with our friends and Family?"

Matt. 4:7 – Jesus said to him, "Again it is written, 'You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.' "Jesus defeats Satan in our place – not by using His power as God but by His perfect obedience in His perfect humanity.
