

FROM OUR PASTOR....

Advent has the wreath, but Lent lacks a tradition like that -- that is, unless you count the discipline of giving up something. The



notion of abstaining from something you enjoy like sweets, social media, or spending can be helpful to the Christian. It takes effort and support to let go of something. Godly discipline is difficult for our human nature. What helps is taking up something at the same time.

This Lent, take up extra prayer and worship. Come to worship more often. Read God's Word and pray at home more often. You can give up something at the same time that you take up something extra that's focused on Jesus Christ and His passion.

Take up two of our Lenten devotional booklets available today: "Deliver Us." Use one in your home. Give the other to a neighbor. Invite them to know that the heart of Lent is not in what we give up, but what God has done to deliver is from sin, death, and devil. These devotions will walk us through the Exodus event and will draw us closer to God's grace and truth. We begin in eleven days. May it be a holy time for us all.
