# From Our Pastor

Christian Education Our ministry Sunday resumes this month, with Adult Bible School. classes. and Confirmation. There might be stops and restarts along the way at church, but at home it can and should go on daily. What's the goal, at church and at home? In two words:

Biblical Literacy.

Lots of us have known the word "illiteracy" to mean something like "not being able to read." Almost of all the members of St. John's can read the Bible, and so one might think we don't have a Biblical illiteracy problem.

But we do. Every church does. The problem is largely twofold: 1) Most of us don't read the Bible. 2) Most of us don't grasp the whole narrative of the Bible -- that is, the overarching true story and how it all fits together.

Our adult Bible classes, Sunday School, and Confirmation curriculum will help grow greater Biblical literacy. We're starting in Genesis this month, walking into Eden to see how we are handmade by God, bearing His image, and redeemed by His intimate love and sacrifice.

None of us, myself included, will be stellar Bible scholars at the end of this year. We will grow in Biblical literacy. More on that in future editions of The Eagle. A blessed Labor Day weekend!
