With Jesus -- born, crucified, buried, and resurrected -- these are good days. Encourage one another with that truth!

This Week's Sunday School Lesson

Lesson 2 Exodus 25:1-19; 40:1-8, 34-38 Today, we will study "A Tent for God." Moses begins the process of building a portable house (called a tabernacle) for the Lord by gathering offerings from the Israelites. God provides detailed instruction for the creation of the ark of the covenant as well as the other fixtures of the tabernacle. When the tabernacle is finally assembled, the glory of the Lord descends on the tabernacle in the form of a cloud. As long as the presence remains, the people remain in that place.
