"Return to The Lord" -Last week it was Joel. Our Midweek Lenten Service this Wednesday will listen to Jeremiah. Many of you have been reading his book and understanding why he's called "the weeping prophet." Jeremiah had good reasons to give up, cash, in, and walk away from his calling. Yet the Lord said to him, "If you return, I will restore you..." (Jer. 15:19).



I'm pretty certain you

have callings in which you're tempted to give up, cash in, and walk away. Yours are not identical to Jeremiah's, but The Lord is the same Lord. He is capable of doing restoration. Here's the thing, though: His restoration is always bound up in the work of Jesus Christ. It always includes repentance and forgiveness, death and resurrection.
