From Our Pastor ...

This is one of those days when my note at the front of The Eagle doesn't have a unifying theme, but consists of important and random items. Here goes...

• I'll start another Adult Catechism Bible Study on Wednesday, April 21, meeting for ten weeks at 7:00 pm. If you'd like to review what Lutherans believe and why, or if you know someone interested in membership with St. John's, this is the class!

• If positivity statistics generally continue as they are now, we're going to begin having some extra events next month. On April 18th we'll hold our first "New Member Welcome" reception in over a year. It will take place at 9:00 am, following the early Service. We'll celebrate our newest members who came to us through transfer, affirmation of faith, or adult confirmation.

• On Easter Day our Youth Board is planning to hold the Easter Breakfast with careful procedures, similar to how Advent and Lenten soup suppers were conducted. The joy of having the breakfast will be far-surpassed by the promise and comfort of the Lord's resurrection.

• Speaking of resurrection, Easter and Ascension were the focus of Confirmation class this week. Our students were asking great questions and realizing that the bodily resurrection of Jesus is essential to the Christian faith. If Jesus didn't rise from death, Christianity is useless. If He did, only Christianity is essential. It was a great class.

• Confirmation classes will likely wrap up on April 14. We have studied the Bible Overview all year and learned a lot. Next year the 6th Grade will do Bible Overview with Jerry Lindsey, and 7th - 8th Grade will study Luther's Small Catechism with me.

• I want to plead with and encourage all the parents of Sunday School kids: come to the Bible Class at 9:15 am Sunday up in the Trinity Room! I lead a study of the same lesson your children are studying, and it will bless you and your kids when you discuss the day's story together. This Sunday we examine wisdom through King Solomon.

• We received a very nice letter of thanks regarding our hosting of the LLL Convention last Saturday. See it on the main bulletin board, and know how grateful I am for the way you welcomed them last weekend.

• This week lots of people will mark St. Patrick's Day. For some fun and some teaching, on Monday I'll repost a satirical YouTube cartoon to our church Facebook page. The point? Confession of the Holy Trinity is as essential as the resurrection of our Lord! A little laughter is good, too.
