"Make me strong to resist any temptation to take what does not rightfully belong to me. Give me the courage to suffer losses rather than to inflict them on others. Help me to realize that life consists not in the abundance of things which I possess, but rather in what I do with what I possess, whether much or little."

That's a timely prayer. So is this:

"Forgive me, for the sake of Thy dear Son, for breaking the 7th commandment in heart and in action. I offer no excuse; I only depend upon Thy mercy. Create in me a clean heart, O Lord, and renew a right spirit within me."

Old prayers are still relevant because people don't change much, & God doesn't change at all.
