Jesus Is Born

Children costumed as Mary, Joseph, shepherds, and angels come forward to pantomime the action and create a manger scene during the reading of the Gospel.

- **Lilli:** And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with a great fear.
- **Avery:** And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger."
- **Aleece:** And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying, "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom He is pleased."

Away in a Manger

1. Away in a manger, no crib for a bed, (*Place hands, palms together, on one side of head.*) The little Lord Jesus laid down His sweet head. (*Switch sides with hands.*)

The stars in the bright sky looked down where He lay, (Extend fingers out, making "stars," then shield eyes for "looked.")

The little Lord Jesus asleep on the hay. (Hold arms in front as if holding a baby.)

- 2. The cattle are lowing, the baby awakes, (Place hands on either side of head and open palms wide.) But little Lord Jesus, no crying He makes. (Rub eyes with closed fists and shake head "no.") I love You, Lord Jesus! Look down from the sky, (Give yourself a hug! Then shield eyes to "look.") And stay by my side till morning is nigh. (Hold arms in front as if holding a baby.)
