### Nicene Creed



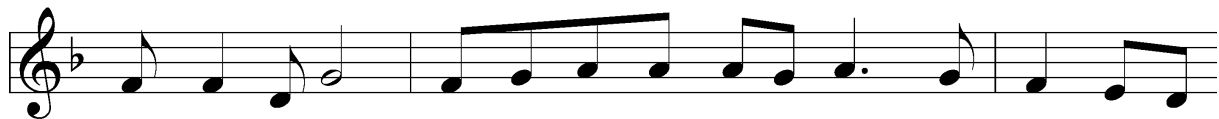
