
# **THE EAGLE** St. John's Weekly Newsletter May 22, 2022

It's planting season! Let's discuss "Church Planting" during adult Bible Class in the fellowship hall at 9:15am Sunday.



*Crown Him with many crowns!* Two years ago this week we were in the midst of that strange exile from in-person church worship, but on Ascension Day we held a Service of the Word –

in the parking lot. It was more than a novelty. It was corporate worship of the King of Kings. Jesus appeared to His disciples over forty days after His resurrection, then ascended bodily to the right hand of God (which is everywhere). We worshiped that evening, acknowledging that "the Lamb Who was slain has begun His reign!" (from "this Is The Feast). This Thursday we won't hold a Service, but you can and should mark Ascension Day in your home devotions, praising God that Jesus is reigning. He even uses the crazy and hurtful things of this world to accomplish His mission. Jesus rules. Rejoice!

Last year this week we were honored to have Rev. Craig Muehler as our guest preacher and teacher on Armed Forces Sunday. He serves as the Director of all LCMS chaplains, and brought us the good news of Jesus. Perhaps you'll use the bulletin insert today to support our chaplains. They do tremendous work, and need our prayer support.
