Members should have an adventurist spirit but it is not a difficult experience. Meals, lodging, & transportation will be provided. - Pray that the Lord of the harvest will send the associate pastor in His time and manner.
- Submit names of pastoral candidates for our associate pastor position during October.
 - It is not necessary that the pastor you are suggesting knows about, or consents to, your submission of his name at this time.
 - The pastor must be on the clergy roster of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod.

To submit a name for consideration:

- Take a nomination form from the Welcome Center. (Forms available Sept. 25 Oct. 31)
- Place the completed form in the offering plate during any worship service between Sept. 25 – Oct. 31

The associate pastor will work alongside Pastor Burdick, working first in all dimensions of our ministry and later specializing in those areas that Pastor Burdick, the Associate Pastor, & congregational leaders believe best match the needs of the congregation and the gifts of the pastor.

It is likely that we will not be calling until early 2023. The Lord will provide. May His will be done!
