In the calendar year of 2022, St. John's Food Pantry served 1,955 individuals (1,563 adults & 392 children). Without the continued support of our congregation of food, monetary gifts, and additional support from other congregations and our great community, our mission of the food pantry would not be possible.

The pantry received cash donations of \$29,013.42, plus the many tangible food items that we have no dollar figure for and it was all distributed to those in need.
