Oh, do not let them rise again to torment me, those harsh defacements of my fellowman, those words that flew,

arrows fiery with my anger, those proud and brittle clashes of me against my neighbor, those ragged neglects of simple duty.

Your Son's cross stands empty against the

sky.

Your Son's grave is opened wide.

Your angels have spoken.

And Your Son sits at Your right hand for me, for me.

Let me remember this;
let me forget.
