This Week's Sunday School Lesson Acts 6-7

This week, students will study "A Servant Speaks." The Twelve select Stephen as one of the first seven deacons in the Early Synagogue Church. leaders twist Stephen's words, falsely accusing him of blasphemy. Stephen's testimony before the high priest recalls Israel's rejection of God's promise and their rejection of Jesus, the promised Savior. When Stephen says he sees a vision of Jesus standing at the right hand of God, the enraged officials cast Stephen out of the city and stoned him. As a family, consider discussing, "How does the death of Stephen affect the other believers?"
