Dear members and friends of St. John's,

Pastor Tim Keller wrote a salient article about this recently. He got me thinking...

- What's the front porch of my life, and our family's life together?

From such porches you can share "the reason for the hope that you have." (1 Peter 3:15). You and I – and our St. John's church family collectively – can listen to our neighbors' needs and burdens, their wayward ideas, and their burning questions, and

winsomely share the hope we have as redeemed sinners. For example, we can say, "I, too, am frustrated by the failures of government. I not only need to do my small part to act with integrity, I need to remember that our lives (yours and mine) find their worth not in what people have done but in what God has done in His mercy."

The first step to using the porch? Be there! Be prepared for a neighbor to be welcomed by you. Listen. Seek to understand. Encourage their questions. Then, "give the reason for the hope that is in you, but do it with gentleness and respect." (1 Peter 3:15).
