Nicene Creed

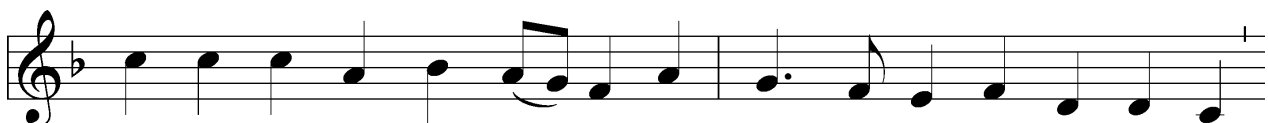
