
THE EAGLE St. John's Weekly Newsletter June 22, 2025



If you were one of the many participants in our witnessing training sessions in summer 2024, you have a great resource in your home. The "EveryOne His Witness" core module book is full of practical guidance on how to speak up about the hope you have in Jesus.

One of the first things I remember from the training was Dr. Wood's statement, "You're not qualified to bring someone to faith in Jesus." I was relieved to hear him say that. Then he added, "But God is qualified to make use of you as His witness." It's true! God is able to make you His tool to share the hope which flows from knowing Christ as Lord. You don't have to be a pastor. You simply have to tell what God has done in Christ – like the man from the Gerasenes in our Gospel this Sunday.

Practice will make you more comfortable. Take a few practice swings in the safe "batting cage" of your home. Actually practice sharing the Christian hope that is in you with a family member. Something like, "I have hope in my life. I know I'm a sinner, and yet I also know God's love and mercy. It's wonderful to be certain that Jesus died for me. I hope you believe that, too."

Such a conversation is only appropriate after you've listened to the non-believing person with your ears and your heart. Listen first. Listen more. Then share. God is qualified to make use of you.
