Many of us remember this painting from the fall, when we studied Jesus' visit with Mary and Martha in Bible study. I believe it's one of Pastor Burdick's favorites. It beautifully illustrates this week's Gospel lesson from Luke 10:38–42.

Take a look at the woman in the foreground who appears to be cooking—this is Martha. She's the sister who welcomed Jesus into her home. Martha is doing exactly what Jesus encouraged in last week's Gospel lesson—the Parable of the Good Samaritan. She is serving and loving her neighbor by preparing a meal for Jesus.

Now, look through the window in the upper right. There, you see Jesus teaching. He is speaking to Mary, Martha's sister. Mary is sitting and listening to the Teacher—listening to Jesus.

Both sisters are doing what they believe is right. Yet, as often happens with us as sinful humans, Martha becomes frustrated with Mary. In Luke 10:40, Martha says to Jesus, "Lord, don't you care that my sister has left me to do the work by myself?"

Think about your own life and relationships. Martha's reaction isn't far-fetched—many of us would feel the same way. But listen to how Jesus responds. He says:

"Martha, Martha... you are worried and upset about many things, but few things are needed or indeed only one. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her." Jesus' response is surprising. He gently corrects Martha. And in doing so, He teaches us an important lesson: Serving our neighbors is important, but listening to Jesus is even more important. Martha was doing good work, but Mary had chosen the better path—being present with Jesus and hearing His word.

So this week, and always, no matter how much or how well you serve others, remember to take time to listen to Jesus.
