# St. John's Weekly Newsletter August 10, 2025

The closing hymn for the 5:30 and 8:00 services this week is Hymn 912 in the LSB, titled *Christ Is Our Cornerstone*. This hymn highlights a major theme found in our readings for the week: the Lord provides us with everything we need. Each of the three verses reinforces a timeless truth. This truth was very relevant even in the era in which the hymn was originally written.

Christ Is Our Cornerstone was composed sometime in the 8th century A.D. Originally written in Latin, it was translated into English in the 1800s by John Chandler. The timing of its composition offers insight into the significance of its focus on the Lord's provision.

The 8th century was a pivotal time in Church history. One of the most significant events was the Second Council of Nicaea in 787. The first Council of Nicaea (325) gave us the Nicene Creed, and the second addressed the issue of the worship of icons. Icons, which are images of Jesus or other biblical figures, were banned from being objects of worship. This reaffirmed that only Christ is to be worshipped, not manmade representations of Him.

Perhaps this is why the first verse of Christ Is Our Cornerstone begins with the words:

> "Christ is our Cornerstone, On Him alone we build;"

Regardless, the hymn is a reminder that Christ is our foundation and our provider.

God is truly at work—using words written by His people almost 1,300 years ago to strengthen and encourage His people today. As we sing the closing hymn together, reflect on the *saints who now fill the courts of Heaven* (v.2) and once sang these same words. We join them in trusting that God's Word endures forever. Thanks be to God!
